Ravenna is known for its stunning mosaics, which can be found in the town's numerous churches and baptisteries. They house some of the world's most dazzling collections of early Christian mosaic artwork. Ravenna is steeped in history; it was the capital of the Western Roman Empire and during this prolonged golden age, Ravenna became a fertile studio for skilled craftsmen, who covered the city's terracotta brick churches in beautiful mosaics. Dante is buried in Ravenna and Lord Byron also spent some time here.



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
